ALCOHOL AT SCHOOL EVENTS POLICY

The Wallington Public School District is deeply concerned about the issue of substance abuse (drugs & alcohol). It has a detailed Chemical Substance Abuse Prevention and Control Policy. The Board believes that it is important for all adults, staff and non-staff, to model behavior that is in the spirit of substance abuse prevention at all times.

Accordingly, the Board has established the following procedures concerning the consumption of alcohol at school-related events:

- Alcohol is prohibited at school sponsored student events (i.e. prom, senior class dinner, class or group trips, athletic awards dinner, etc.).
- It is recommended, and strongly encouraged, that alcohol not be served at “off-site” events attended by our students (i.e. Home & School Fashion Show, Thanksgiving Beefsteak, **Academic/Athletic Hall of Fame Dinner**, fundraising dinners and other events, etc.).
- If alcohol is available to adults at an “off-site” event, there must be supervision of students at all times.
