ADMISSION POLICY

KINDERGARTEN

Any child residing in the district shall be admitted to the kindergarten provided:

- A. The child will have attained the age of five (5) years on or before November 1 of that school year.
- B. Proof shall be furnished concerning immunization against the listed communicable diseases at the time of registration/enrollment.
 - 1. Diphtheria - Pertussis - Tetanus (DPT)
 - 2. Poliomyelitis (Polio)
 - 3. Measles (Rubeola)
 - 4. German Measles (Rubeola)
 - 5. Mumps
 - 6. Mantoux Tuberculin Test
- C. The child shall have been examined by either a school or private physician and the results provided to the school.
- D. Residency status can be verified.

GRADES ONE THROUGH TWELVE

Pupils transferring into the district are expected to present the following documentation at the time of registration.

- A. Proof of Residency
This may be in the form of a sales contract or a copy of a lease or rental agreement.
- B. Official Birth Certificate or Passport
- C. Child's Social Security number
- D. Transfer Card/Papers (if being transferred from another public or private school)
- E. Health Records/Proof of Immunization
- F. Proof of guardianship (if parents are divorced)

Academic records should be sent as soon as possible (English

translation if necessary). Initial placement shall be made on the basis of information available at the time of registration. Adjustments may be made at the discretion of the administration when academic records and/or state mandated assessments indicate that they would be beneficial to the child.

In all cases, grades K-12, if a child's family is domiciled with a resident family in Wallington proof of that residency will be required in the form of a notarized affidavit (Affidavit form C) from the landlord, if the resident family rents or leases or the homeowner, if the resident family owns their own home.
